Thursday, June 20th, Portland Art Museum:

Join the Trekkers as we start this year off with a cultural exploration of our own Portland Art Museum.

This summer, the Portland Art Museum presents Monet to Matisse: French Moderns, a stunning exhibition featuring nearly 60 modernist masterpieces from the Brooklyn Museum's renowned European collection.

The exhibition highlights France's role as the heart of modern art from the mid-1800s to the mid-1900s. It showcases a diverse range of paintings and sculptures in various sizes, styles, and subject matters. Explore iconic movements like Impressionism, Symbolism, Fauvism, Cubism, and Surrealism through the works of legendary artists such as Paul Cézanne, Marc Chagall, Edgar Degas, Henri Matisse, Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, and many more.

Monet to Matisse: French Moderns is curated by Lisa Small, Senior Curator of European Art, and Richard Aste, former Curator of European Art, both from the Brooklyn Museum.

After our eyes are full of the beautiful art and our bellies rumbling after the museum, let's show our love and support and head to Bannings for lunch.

Trekker Terms and Conditions

Active Elements, Medical Conditions, and Special Assistance

Some Trekkers' tours and excursions incorporate active elements that require the ability to walk varying distances, climb stairs, and move without assistance. Registered participants are responsible for familiarizing themselves with the level of activity involved in the tour in advance.

Participants must disclose in their Participant Information Form (or at such later time when they become aware of such a condition) if any physical or mental illness, disability, pregnancy or any other condition will create a health hazard for the participant or other participants during the tour, or will require medical attention or special accommodation during the tour.

We will make reasonable efforts to accommodate such needs. However, we **MUST** be notified at the time of booking of such needs so that we can determine what assistance we can reasonably provide.

We cannot accommodate requests for assistance with ordinary daily activities, such as walking and eating. We will not physically lift or assist participants on to or off of any vehicles.

If we cannot accommodate a participant's special needs, they must be accompanied by a companion who will be responsible for independently providing the needed assistance.

We reserve the right to refuse the participation of anyone we consider unsuitable for the tour due to fitness level. We also reserve the right to remove a participant from the tour, at the participant's own expense, if they have an undisclosed condition that creates a hazard to the participant or others, or otherwise negatively impacts the enjoyment of the other participants in the tour.
