Note: The special awards ceremony featured unique keeper trophies in the form of handcrafted dubloons created by Chris Gammage. Each piece was made using 50 recycled aluminium ring pulls, melted down and cast into a distinctive medallion featuring the ASW logo. On the reverse, the Latin inscription “Each Endeavouring all Achieving” reflects the national motto of Antigua & Barbuda, accompanied by four national symbols: the black pineapple, a sugar mill, a turtle, and a sunrise representing the national flag. The presentation opened the special awards segment, celebrating both sporting achievement and the spirit of sustainability and national pride embodied in these bespoke trophies.
