

Setting Priorities for the Remaining ARPA Funds

- **Step 1: Collecting Public Input.** The City is asking residents to **fill out a public input form** to prioritize different possible areas of investment and to suggest specific ways its remaining ARPA funds might be spent.
- **Step 2: Reporting Public Input and Narrowing Our Options.** The City will aggregate and analyze the input received and present a report to the public with a narrower list of priorities, with specific types of investments it could make for each priority category.
- **Step 3: Holding a Series of Community Meetings** to ask for further feedback about possible investments/expenditures in the narrowed list of categories.
- **Step 4: Circulating the Results from the Public Meetings** and preparing possible legislation for consideration by Cleveland Heights City Council.
