Cain Park Announces Its Extended 2023 Season

Concerts by Grammy winning, critically acclaimed folk, jazz, acoustic, rock, R&B and soul artists; free concerts; dance performances; Pride in the Park, a new Stand-Up Comedy series; a circus and fun with science; wine tastings, an art gallery, and two Broadway musicals. All under the sun and stars!

CLEVELAND HEIGHTS, OHIO—The City of Cleveland Heights has announced the extended 2023 Cain Park Season, which kicks off this Saturday, May 20, with a performance by Grammy-winning folk legend Judy Collins, backed by a full symphony orchestra, and runs through September.

Cain Park is home to two outdoor performance spaces—the Evans Amphitheater and the Alma Theater—and the Feinberg Art Gallery. All three spaces offer opportunities for an art-filled summer, including nearly 100 performances and featuring the work of hundreds of artists.

Jonathan Larson’s Pulitzer-Prize-winning phenomenon, ***RENT***, shaped a generation, and its legacy has continued for over 25 years. Based loosely on Giacomo Puccini’s *La Boheme*, this rock musical follows a year in the life of a group of young artists struggling to create and survive in New York’s Lower East Side under the shadow of poverty, social unrest, and the AIDS epidemic. With universal themes of falling in love, finding one’s voice, and living for today, ***RENT*** teaches us to measure our lives in love.
