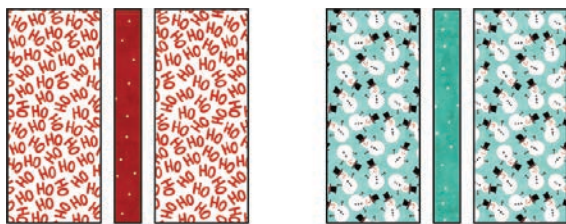
- WOF = Width Of Fabric folded selvage to selvage
- All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Press fabric before cutting
- Cut and label all fabric prior to sewing
- Finished size: 63" x 85

## Step 1: Cut and label all fabrics

## Step 2: Pieced Blocks

1. Sew a **fabric 3**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **B** strip in between (2)  $4$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangles; make (10). Press to **B**.
2. Repeat with the **fabric 4** **B** strips.



Make (10) **fabric 3** & (10) **fabric 4**

## Step 3: Half Square-Triangles (HST)

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (20) **fabric 5**  $3$ " x  $3$ " **D** squares.



2. Place a marked **D** square, right side down over the right side of a **fabric 3**  $3$ " x  $3$ " **C** square.
3. Stitch with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on either side of the traced line.
4. Cut the sewn block on the traced line and press the seams to **fabric 3**. Repeat with the remaining (9)  $3$ " x  $3$ " **fabric 3** **C** squares.
5. Repeat with the **fabric 4**  $3$ " x  $3$ " **C** squares and the (10)  $3$ " x  $3$ " **fabric 5** **D** squares.
6. Trim the squares to measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make (20) **fabric 3** HSTs  
and (20) **fabric 4** HSTs

7. Sew a **fabric 5**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **E** square to the left side of a **fabric 3** HST unit; repeat on the right side of a **fabric 3** HST unit; make (10) of each.
8. Repeat with the **fabric 4** HSTs.

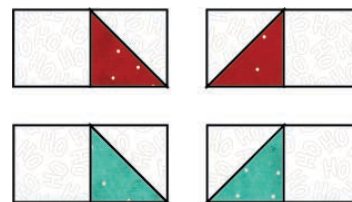

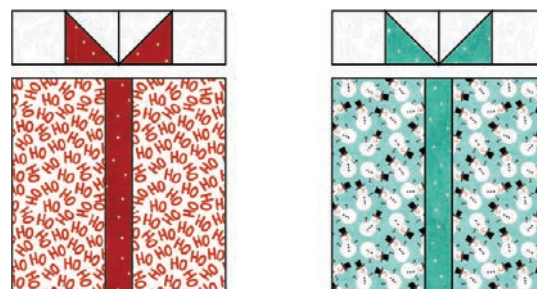

9. Sew the left/right units together, (10) **fabric 3** & (10) **fabric 4**.



## Step 4: Pieced Blocks

1. Sew a **fabric 3/white** HST unit to the top of the a **fabric 3** **A/B** block. Repeat with the **fabric 4/white** HST units; make (10) of each.

2. Sew a **fabric 1**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **F** strip to the top and bottom edge of a pieced block.
3. Sew a **fabric 1**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **G** strip to the left and right edges of the pieced block.
4. Repeat with the **fabric 2** strips; make a total of (10) with **fabric 1** and (10) with **fabric 2** borders.



Make (10) **fabric 1** and (10) **fabric 2**

## Step 5: The Quilt Center

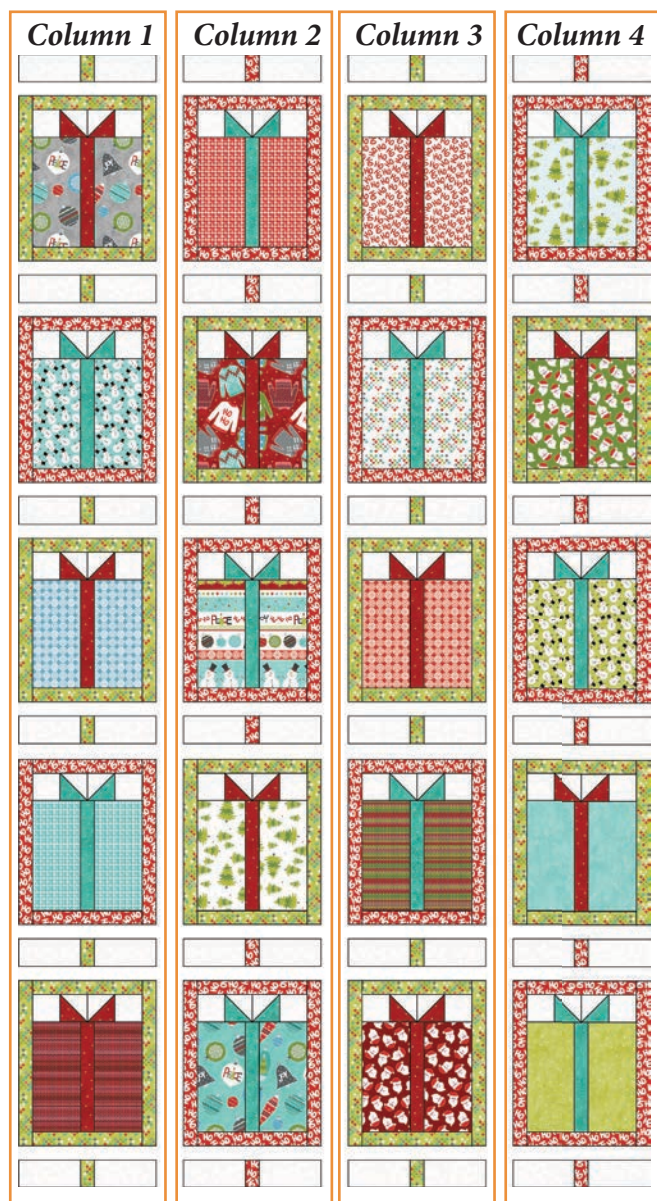
1. Sew a **fabric 5**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5$ " **S1** strip to the left and right edges of a **fabric 1**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **S** strip; repeat with the **fabric 2**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **S** strips.
2. Make a total of (10) green/white and (10) red/white **S1** units.



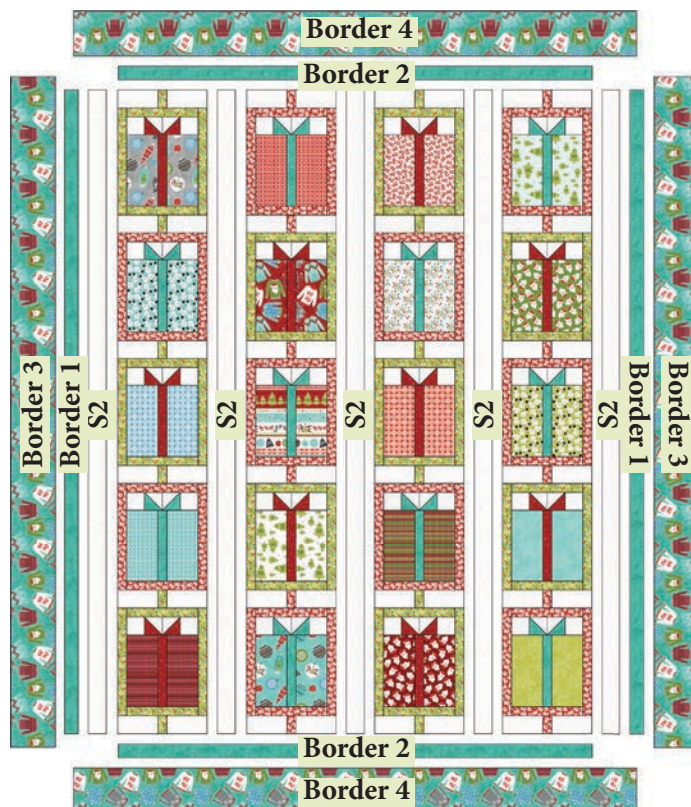
Make (10) green/white

- Follow the diagram below to assemble 4 quilt columns using the pieced blocks and **S1** units:



- Sew (4) of the (7) **fabric 6**  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF border strips end to end and cut (2)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $75\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 3** strips; sew onto the left and right edges of the quilt.
- Sew the remaining **fabric 6** strips end to end and cut (2)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $63\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 4** strips; sew onto the top and bottom edges of the quilt.



### Step 7: Finishing

- Layer the quilt backing, batting and quilt top, and quilt as desired.
- Bind with the (8) **fabric 3**  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF binding strips, label and enjoy!

### Step 6: Assemble the Quilt Top

- Sew the remaining  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **fabric 5** strips end to end and cut (5)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $72\frac{1}{2}$ " **S2** strips.
- Sew the **S2** strips in between the assembled columns to make the quilt center.
- Sew (3) **fabric 4**  $2$ " x WOF and cut into (2)  $2$ " x  $53\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 2** strips; set aside.
- Sew the remaining  $2$ " **fabric 4** strips end to end and cut (2)  $2$ " x  $72\frac{1}{2}$ " **border 1** strips; sew onto the left and right edges of the quilt center.
- Sew the (2)  $2$ " x  $53\frac{1}{2}$ " **fabric 4 border 2** strips to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center.
