### What we've been up to...

#### **KITTENS! KITTENS! KITTENS!**

HSLC has provided shelter, food, water and vet care for over 300 kittens so far this year. Kitten season typically occurs from early spring through late fall, with a peak in the warmer months.

During this time, unspayed female cats go into heat more frequently and have the potential to give birth to multiple litters, with an average of 4-6 kittens born per litter. This can really add up! Be a part of the solution and TNR your outdoor cats.






### How you can help...

Trap-Neuter-Return, or TNR, involves trapped, fixing, vaccinating and eartipping the feral and stray cats in a colony, then returning them to their territory. This prevents unwanted litter, future suffering, over population and also keeps cats out of shelters.



Call your local township building for TNR programs and vouchers in your area!










