Information and Referral: Provide information, refer consumers to other agencies in our network to assist in gaining independence.

Peer Mentoring: Peer Mentors with disabilities serve as role models, provide moral support and share creative solutions related to living with disability.

Housing: Referrals for housing or home modification.

Individual and Systems Advocacy: Work with you on self advocacy assertiveness to personal empowerment; Regional Consultants for all five titles of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Independent Living Skills Training: Assistance with writing your resume', keeping your check book, calling for transportation, obtaining an assistive device, etc.

Loan Locker: Free short & long-term equipment loans, such as wheelchairs, walkers, canes, and etc.

Assistive Technology Program: Short-term loans of assistive technology on a "try before you buy" basis; assistive technology assessments and training; alternative finance solutions for the purchase of assistive technology.

Florida Telecommunications Relay Distribution Center (FTRI): Free amplified phones for people who are deaf/hard of hearing or speech impaired.
