You can access *Child Advocates* Online by typing the URL in your browser, or by visiting the Support Center for Child Advocates <u>website</u>.







Creating a new Child Advocates Online account

- 1. Visit https://phillychildadvocates.litmos.com/ and click *Register*.
 - Do not type "www." in your browser before phillychildadvocates.litmos.com. The site will not load if you include "www."



- 2. Complete the Online Courses Self-sign Up form by entering your first name, last name, and primary work email address. This email address will also act as your username, so please choose an email address that you will remember. You will always use this email to log in. Once completed, Click *Register*.
 - If you submit this form and accidentally leave one of the fields blank, you may be asked to enter a code on your second submission attempt. The code is "CEA".



3. Once submitted, you will be directed to check your email for additional information. Please check the email address you just submitted in the previous form.



- 4. You will receive an email with your login information. Click the link at the end of the email to complete your registration and open *Child Advocates* Online.
 - o This email may take up to 4 hours to deliver. If you cannot find this email in your inbox, please check your spam or junk folders, or search for emails from system@litmos.com. If you still have not received the email after 4 hours, reach out to Sarah Dlugos at sdlugos@sccalaw.org.


Logging into an Existing Child Advocates Online Account

- 2. Enter your username (this should be your email address) and password, and click *Login*.




1. Click I've forgotten my username/password on the Login page.




2. Enter your username (this is your email address) and click Continue.



NAVIGATING THE HOMEPAGE

On the left of the home page, you will find several options: *Home, Content Library, Achievements, Live Sessions*, and *Collapse Menu*.


- **Content Library** All courses and learning paths available for self registration are listed here. Use the Search bar at the top of the list to search for a specific course. To play a course, click on the title of the course.
- Achievements All Achievements are listed here. If the course has a certificate of completion to download, you can select download my certificate next to the Achievement. Completed courses are listed here. You are also able to re-access any courses that have already been completed from this page.
- Live Sessions All live webinars are listed here.




Searching for a Course

Your *Recently Viewed*, *Popular Categories*, and *Favorited Courses* are saved on the *Content Library* homepage.






Beginning a Course and Checking Course Progress

To begin a course, press **Start This Course** or click the title of the first module. Your course progress is displayed by percentage complete on the right side of the course page.


A course is considered 100% complete when you have finished all modules, surveys, and assessments.



Downloading a Certificate of Completion

Please note: these are general course certificates of completion, not certificates for professional credit, such as CLEs or CEUs.

- 1. To download a course certificate of completion, click *Achievements* on the right side of the homepage.
- 2. Type the name of the course in the search bar and click **Search**. Click **Download Certificate** next to the course name.



CHILD ADVOCATES ONLINE GLOSSARY

Child Advocates Online - A library of online courses, resources, and educational materials geared toward those working with children and families

Learning Management System (LMS) - a software application for the administration, documentation, tracking, reporting, automation and delivery of educational courses, training programs, or learning and development programs. *Child Advocates* Online is a learning management system and you may hear it referred to as an "LMS."

Content Library - A tab on the left side of the *Child Advocates* Online homepage where all courses and learning paths are listed

Course - An online course or recorded webinar about one topic. The actual instructional content of the course is broken up into modules.

Module - The instructional content of each course. Modules can be videos, quizzes, surveys, etc.

Learning Path - A grouping of multiple courses that all share a similar theme. For example, all courses in our Children's Docket Brown Bag Training Series are found in our Children's Docket Brown Bag Training Series Learning Path.

"All" Tab on Homepage - This tab displays all of your assigned courses and courses you have in progress. To see the entire collection of our available courses and learning paths, click the content library tab on the left side of the homepage.

"In Progress" Tab on Homepage - This tab displays all of the courses you have in progress.

"Overdue" Tab on Homepage - This tab displays all assigned courses that are overdue.

"Not Started" Tab on Homepage - This tab displays all assigned courses that have not been started.

"Completed" Tab on Homepage - This tab displays all the courses that are 100% complete. Courses are considered 100% completed when you have completed all modules.
