

# Top 10 National Parks for an Unforgettable RV Adventure

Whether you're a seasoned RVer or planning your first big trip, America's national parks offer some of the most awe-inspiring scenery in the world. Here are our top 10 destinations that belong on every RV traveler's bucket list — plus insider tips to help you make the most of each stop.

## Yellowstone National Park – Wyoming, Montana & Idaho



**Why Go:** Geysers, hot springs, wildlife, and America's first national park — Yellowstone has it all.

**RV Tip:** Book campsites early! [Fishing Bridge RV Park](#) is the only campground with full hookups inside the park. Always keep a safe distance from all wildlife; there's no shortage of animals here. Watch for bison—they have a knack for causing traffic jams.

**Don't Miss:** Old Faithful and the Grand Prismatic Spring – go at sunrise for stunning colors and fewer crowds.

## Grand Canyon National Park – Arizona

**Why Go:** Few sights on earth compare to your first glimpse over the canyon rim.

**RV Tip:** Stay at [Trailer Village RV Park](#) on the South Rim for full hookups and a shuttle stop nearby. If you're boondocking, the Kaibab National Forest offers scenic and free dispersed camping just outside the park gates.

**Don't Miss:** Sunset at Mather Point — pack a picnic and a camera. Don't forget your water!



## Glacier National Park – Montana



**Why Go:** Jaw-dropping mountain passes, turquoise lakes, and endless hiking trails await.

**RV Tip:** Going-to-the-Sun Road is restricted to smaller RVs (under 21 feet long), but you can park and hop on the park's free shuttle system. [Apgar and St. Mary Campgrounds](#) are great home bases.

**Don't Miss:** Lake McDonald at dawn — glassy reflections and alpine glow make for postcard-perfect photos.

## Grand Teton National Park – Wyoming



**Why Go:** Miraculous mountain views, alpine lakes and peaceful trails.

**RV Tip:** [Colter Bay RV Park](#) offers full hookups, laundry, and a dump station, all near Jackson Lake. For a more rustic option, [Gros Ventre Campground](#) accommodates larger rigs and gives easy access to both the park and Jackson hole. Reserve early—summer sites fill fast.

**Don't Miss:** Lake Jenny Scenic Drive, Snake River Overlook, The Cunningham Cabins, and kayaking on Jackson Lake.

---

## Yosemite National Park – California



**Why Go:** Iconic Granit Cliffs, Waterfalls and the giant sequoias

**RV Tip:** [Upper Pines Campground](#) accommodates RVs up to 35 feet and is centrally located in Yosemite Valley, making it easy to access iconic sites like Yosemite Falls and Half Dome. Reservations are required well in advance, especially for summer. For larger rigs or those seeking hookups, nearby private RV parks just outside the park provide full services and shuttle access to the valley.

**Don't Miss:** Half Dome, Yosemite Falls, Glacier Point, and Mariposa Grove.

---

### Zion National Park – Utah



**Why Go:** Towering red cliffs, slot canyons, and a photographer's dream at every turn.

**RV Tip:** [Watchman Campground](#) accommodates RVs and is within walking distance to the park's shuttle system. Arrive early — spots fill up fast.

**Don't Miss:** The easy Riverside Walk for a taste of The Narrows without getting your feet wet.

---

### Great Smoky Mountains – Tennessee & North Carolina

**Why Go:** Rolling mountains, lush forests, and abundant wildlife. Located near Gatlinburg and Dollywood so plenty to do outside of the park too!

**RV Tip:** [Cades Cove Campground](#) offers big-rig-friendly sites, though no hookups—bring a generator.

**Don't Miss:** Cades Cove Loop, Clingmans Dome, and hiking to Laurel Falls.



## Arches National Park – Utah



**Why Go:** More than 2,000 natural stone arches and surreal red rock formations.

**RV Tip:** [Devils Garden Campground](#) accommodates RVs up to 40 feet and offers a great base for exploring the park's arches and trails. There are no hookups, so be prepared with water and supplies. For larger rigs or full-service amenities, nearby private RV parks in Moab provide hookups, and easy access to the park entrance. Arrive early, especially in spring and fall, as campsites fill quickly

**Don't Miss:** Delicate Arch, Landscape Arch, and the Windows Section.

---

## Acadia National Park – Maine

**Why Go:** Ocean views meet mountain trails — the best of both worlds on the rugged Maine coast.



**RV Tip:** [Blackwood's](#) and [Seawall Campgrounds](#) are great in-park options (no hookups, but generators are allowed at certain hours). Nearby private campgrounds offer full amenities.

**Don't Miss:** Drive up Cadillac Mountain for sunrise — it's the first place in the U.S. to see the morning sun.

---

## Rocky Mountain National Park – Colorado

**Why Go:** Majestic peaks, alpine lakes, and abundant wildlife.

**RV Tip:** [Moraine Park Campground](#) accommodates RVs up to 40 feet and is centrally located near many trailheads. There are no hookups, so plan accordingly. For full-service amenities, nearby private RV parks in Estes Park are available and offer water, electric, and dump stations. Summer reservations are essential, as spots fill months ahead of time.

**Don't Miss:** Drive the Trail Ridge Road for breathtaking alpine views, hike to Bear Lake or Emerald Lake, and visit the Alpine Visitor Center for panoramic vistas. Wildlife spotting is a must—keep an eye out for elk, moose, and bighorn sheep.
