Weekend Membership: Rick Myers

Must use New form, something was needed to fix the process, make things consistent. All participants must be SCCA members, either annual or weekend. Driver fills out left hand side; navigator fills out trial membership, right hand side. Region is being billed \$10 per car, fee is actually \$15, check with your region for how much you need to submit. A Weekend Member actively participates; a trial member is a ride-along, not active participant; this is not exactly how road rally works, but this is how it is being handled. Why was there not more notice? Things snowballed. Effective date? Now?? As of convention, maybe push back to July 1? Rick will go back to Executive Team and ask. *Update: The effective date for full implementation of this is the end of the first quarter of 2020, March 31, April 6.*

Mike King, new director of Rally/Solo: will treat rally equal with solo, values all programs equally; will do what he can to help rally grow and prosper

Cheryl – RRRs states that a Regional Development Committee is required to be appointed by the RRB. Jim C. stated that the RRB is acting in that capacity.

John Poulos – who looks to the future, who develops rallies for the regions? Peter S stated that he reached out to 27 REs (from survey, Cristina Poole), it's slowly happening; Jim said that the RRB focus used to be the peak of the pyramid, i.e. nationals, now focused on base of pyramid, i.e. regional development

Peter – RRSS, automated test for renewal coming soon, maybe this year

John Poulos – calendar on line and in Sportscar based on sanction, can this be changed to allow listing without sanctioning? Brian Harmer says highly unlikely because sanctioning triggers the process to put items up. Chris Regan asked what about online sanctioning to get things started? Brian – coming, but a year or two or three down the line. Jeanne's calendar can be put in an easier to find location on the rally page.

Chris R – what is RRB's goal for the new year? On agenda for tomorrow's meeting. More regions, more rallies, more contestants. Mike K is willing to set up private Facebook pages for info, questions, share ideas, etc
