### **1971 Volvo 142S**

### **1952 Hudson Hornet Club Coupe**

The Davis' acquired the car out of California in 2018. The GAMRR will be the first significant trip this car has seen since the 1960s.

The car is powered by the legendary Hornet 308 cubic inch, flat-head six cylinder engine with Twin-H carburetion. It is one of 8300 Hornet Club Coupes built for 1952. At 3550 pounds it was the lightest of the Hornets and the darling of stock car racers.
