

Get to Know the 2018 SCCA RoadRally Members — 2018 RoadRally Board Bios

Mike Bennett: Mike has been involved in SCCA RoadRally since 1998. In addition to competing in Stock Class at Region, Division and (occasionally) National levels, Mike served as the Rally Director for the Detroit Region for three years, as the RoadRally Steward for Central Division, and has been the RoadRally Steward for the Great Lakes Division since its inception. He is also a RoadRally Safety Steward and Instructor. Mike joined the RoadRally Board in 2017 and led the creation of the Safety Steward Knowledge Test. In 2018, Mike will focus on Regional Development along with the rest of the RRB.

Jim Crittenden: Jim ran his first rally in 1968 after meeting W. David Teter at the University of Delaware. Jim has remained active in rallying ever since, as both a competitor and as a Rallymaster. He currently lives in Madison, Wisconsin and is Rallymaster for the Roads Scholar rallies. He served on the National Events Committee (NEC) in 2015 and joined the RRB in 2016.

Jeanne English: Jeanne has been road rallying for 45 years. She really likes course rallies — the game of figuring out the traps and the precision involved. You have to know what the generals say, and what the route instructions say — every word is important.

She joined SCCA forty years ago, became a RoadRally Board member about ten years ago, and after her term was over, she continued as the RRB Secretary. Jeanne is currently the Rocky Mountain Division RoadRally Steward. Locally, she is involved with Santa Monica Sports Car Club (a Chapter of the SCCA Cal Club Region) and the rallies they put on, including the same First Friday Niters that got her started in road rallying.

Wendy Harrison: Wendy is from Indianapolis, Indiana, and currently serves as the RoadRally Chairperson for the SCCA Indianapolis Region. She started running road rallies when she was in High School, then took a long break and started actively running SCCA road rallies again in 2008. She runs several National SCCA RoadRally events each year, but her energy is focused mostly on her local rally program. In 2018, she joined the RoadRally Board and is looking forward to the opportunity to help grow RoadRally from a grassroots perspective.

Clyde Heckler: Clyde joined the SCCA in 1969 when in college and has been a member ever since. Originally a member of Susquehanna Region in central Pennsylvania, he later transferred to the Philadelphia Region and then to South Jersey Region (SJR) serving as Rally Chairman for several years in both regions. Clyde was also Northeast Division RoadRally Steward for a few years. Most recently Clyde moved to the Boston area and is now a member of both the New England Region and South Jersey Region. Over the years Clyde has been involved with RoadRally both at the Regional level and occasionally on the National level as time permitted. After a year on the NEC (National Events Committee), Clyde joined the RoadRally Board in 2016. One of his primary tasks in 2018 will be to develop a toolkit and timeline of tasks for new Rallymasters.

Peter Schneider: Peter started rallying in 1974, and he joined SCCA in 1988 to obtain his ProRally License. Since then he has been an active member in the local Metro NY/NJ and Northeast rally community, along with events in the Pacific Northwest including marathon events like the 'Rally of the Lost Patrol' and 'Alcan 5000' as both event staff and competitor. His primary focus is to expand RoadRallying as a social activity within regions that currently do not have a program to expand the sport within SCCA. Peter was the Northeast Division Rally Steward in the early 90s and is currently serving as their Rally Steward in 2018. Peter joined the RRB in 2017.
