PARSHA MATTERS by RABBI SAM TAYLOR

The name Esther is linked to the word hester, meaning hiddenness. That connection captures the very essence of Purim. In the Book of Esther, G-d's name never appears explicitly. There are no open miracles, no splitting seas, no prophetic declarations. And yet, our tradition teaches that it is precisely within that hiddenness that the deepest revelation unfolds.

Rabbi Nachman of Breslov expressed this idea powerfully: "Even in the hiddenness within hiddenness, there too you can find G-d." Sometimes Hashem is hidden. And sometimes even the fact that He is hidden is itself concealed. Life can feel random, frightening, even chaotic. It is in those moments, Purim teaches, that faith matters most. Esther herself lived this reality. Taken to the palace of Achashveirosh, her Jewish identity concealed, she could not possibly see the larger plan unfolding around her. She was isolated, vulnerable, and unsure of the outcome. Yet from that very place of concealment, she became the instrument of salvation for her people. Her hiddenness was not an obstacle to redemption; it was the pathway to it. The Megillah is indeed filled with what appear to be coincidences. A king's sleepless night, a delayed execution, a series of banquets, and unexpected reversals. Only in hindsight do we see the pattern. The miracle of Purim is not a suspension of nature, but the quiet orchestration of events behind the scenes.

Our own lives contain moments of hester panim, times when God's presence feels distant, and the purpose is unclear. Purim reminds us that the same Divine Providence guiding history is present in the small, hidden details of our daily lives. Even when we cannot see it, the story is still being written. This is why Purim is celebrated with such profound joy. We rejoice not despite the hiddenness, but because of it. We learned that even when we could not see clearly, we were never alone. The hidden became revealed, and that discovery continues to sustain us.

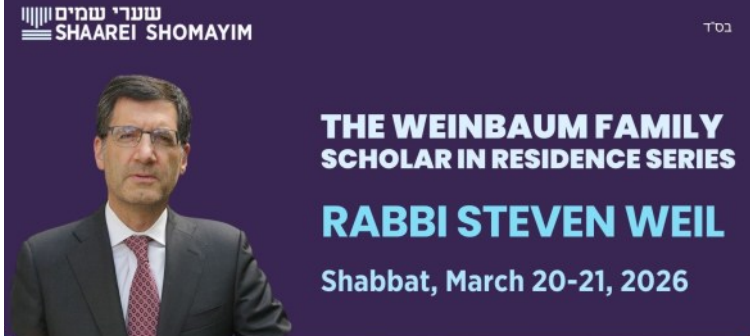
