We hope this letter finds you well. We're writing to share an important community initiative and invite your support for No Wrong Door's *Laundry Love: Newport* program.

Since February 2023, No Wrong Door has partnered with local laundromats to host recurring *Laundry Love* events, helping to relieve the financial burden faced by many individuals and families across Newport County. Thanks to the generosity of our supporters, we have facilitated nearly 100 events, providing more than 3,000 loads of clean clothing and bedding to over 1,200 residents. Each event costs approximately \$500 to cover laundry expenses and essential supplies.

Laundry Love: Newport is open to all Newport County residents and is fully funded through grants and donations. We rely on the continued generosity of community partners like you to sustain this vital program. Past supporters include Blackstone Catering, Custom House Coffee, Salve Regina University, Broden Millworks and Supply, The Aramli Foundation, the Tiverton Lions Club, Newport Mosaic Club, Newport Havurah and many individual donors. Without this collective support, the program would not be able to continue serving those in need.
