Page 124, after line 2, insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 528. ATTENDING PHYSICIAN TO THE CONGRESS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 41 of title 10, United
3 States Code, is amended by inserting before section 716
4 the following new section:

5 “§ 715. Attending Physician to the Congress: grade

6 “A general officer serving as Attending Physician to
7 the Congress, while so serving, holds the grade of major
8 general. A flag officer serving as Attending Physician to
9 the Congress, while so serving, holds the grade of rear ad-
10 miral (upper half).”.

11 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
12 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
13 before the item relating the section 716 the following new
14 item:

“715. Attending Physician to Congress: grade”.

At the end of subtitle A of title V, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 507. GRADES OF CHIEFS OF CHAPLAINS.**

2 (a) ARMY.—Section 3073 of title 10, United States
3 Code, is amended—

4 (1) by inserting “(a)” before “There”; and

5 (2) by adding at the ends the following new
6 subsection:

7 “(b) The Chief of Chaplains, while so serving, holds
8 the grade of major general.”.

9 (b) NAVY.—Section 5142 of title 10, United States
10 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
11 subsection:

12 “(e) The Chief of Chaplains, while so serving, holds
13 the grade of rear admiral (upper half).”.

14 (c) AIR FORCE.—Section 8039 of title 10, United
15 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
16 lowing new subsection:

17 “(c) GRADE OF CHIEF OF CHAPLAINS.—The Chief
18 of Chaplains, while so serving, holds the grade of major
19 general.”.
