STATEMENT OF WORK (CIVILIAN RELIGIOUS MINISTRY PROFESSIONAL) (ROMAN CATHOLIC PRIEST)

1. <u>Background:</u> Pastoral services by an ordained priest are essential to worship and sacramental observance with the Roman Catholic Congregation located at Naval Support Activity South Potomac (NSASP) Chapel, Dahlgren, VA. A contracted Roman Catholic Priest shall provide services in the absence of a military priest or augment such services as directed by the assigned military priest.

2. Objectives and Tasks:

- a. Provide or augment services as a Roman Catholic Priest at the Chapel, NSASP, to include but not limited to:
- (1) As sole provider of Catholic services for the Roman Catholic Congregation, the contractor will conduct 3 weekly Masses, additional special services as needed and any other ministry support for each of the 52 weeks of the contract year.
- (2) If the contractor is unable to conduct a required service, it will be their responsibly to secure a priest with proper faculties to conduct the service in their absence and insure the substitute priest is properly compensated.
- (3) Celebrate Mass and hear confessions as assigned. Minimum assignment currently is for 52 weeks per year to include Friday noon; Saturday evening; Sunday morning (each day to be accounted for and invoiced separately).
- (4) Celebrate Mass on Holy Days of Obligation, providing a Vigil Mass and 1200 Holy Day Mass for each, or a 1200 Holy Day Mass and evening Holy Day Mass based on availability of Priest.
- (5) Celebrate Holy Week Triduum, including an evening penance service, which provides the availability of hearing confession.
- (6) Provide guidance and support as required for the Catholic Religious Education Program, and sacramental preparation and instruction.
- (5) Provide guidance, training/oversight as required and commissioning of individuals in various ministries.

- (6) Available for weddings, baptisms, funerals, and memorial services.
 - (7) Available to provide counseling as needed.
- (8) Available to attend monthly Parish Advisory Council meetings.
- (9) Available to participate in other activities of the community.
 - (10) Meet regularly with Command Chaplain as needed.
- b. During Force Protection Condition (FPCON) Delta and other base closures, the religious ministry professional will not be allowed access to NSASP, Dahlgren, and will be notified by the Chaplain's office/EOC.

3. Invoice Schedule

- (1) Celebrate Mass and hear confessions, Friday \$70
 (per day)
- (2) Celebrate Mass and hear Confessions, Saturday and \$150 Sunday (per day)
- (3) Celebrate Mass on Holy Days of Obligation, providing a \$70 Vigil Mass and 1200 Holy Day Mass for each, or a 1200 Holy Day Mass and evening Holy Day Mass (per each service)
- (4) Celebrate Holy Week Triduum, including an evening \$70 penance service, which provides the availability of hearing confession (per each service)
- (5) Provide Guidance and Services \$50
- (6) Provide services at the Dahlgren Chapel to include \$50 weddings, baptisms, funerals, and memorial services (per each service)
- 4. The Contractor shall be responsible for submitting a monthly invoice in arrears for services completed electronically through Wide Area Workflow (WAWF) in accordance with the Invoice Schedule. A member of the Command Chaplains Office must validate and sign the invoice before submission.
- 5. The Contractor shall be a Catholic Priest with faculties acceptable to the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA.
