The theme for week 4 is "Dragons & Unicorns!" Throughout the week we'll have crafts, science activities, and a snack centered around this theme. All of our snacks are peanut and tree nut free. Outdoor games and water activities will also take place depending on the weather! **Please send your child(ren) in with a bathing suit or change of clothes every day***. We will gauge the weather and get the kids cooled off as much as possible. Please also supply your child with a towel, and optional sandals/flip flops (the ground can get very hot and can be hard to cool down) and sunscreen.

Unvaccinated campers and staff are encouraged but not required to wear masks indoors; campers and staff are not required to wear masks outside. Social distancing will also be implemented so upon arrival, your child will be placed in a group and will remain with that group throughout the day. Toys and games will be sanitized at the end of each day. Parent drop-off and pick-up will be at the side entrance closest to the hill. Only one family at a time may be in the vestibule area during drop-off and pick-up. **Please do not leave your child unattended, staff will be with you as soon as possible. If no one is at the front door please call (518) 227-8097.**

Breakfast and lunch will be provided by the school district at no cost. A form has been e-mailed to families and a final count will be given to the district on Friday morning. If your child's Week 4 form is not submitted, they will not be able to receive meals.

Everything your child needs each day is listed below in the "Important Information" section. Toys from home are not allowed at this time. Electronics will be allowed this summer, but only during certain times of the day which will be clearly marked on the schedule.
