Weather-permitting, we'll go outside as much as possible. Please make sure to send your child with appropriate attire and footwear for outdoor play. If we end up needing to utilize the gym, we'll play games that don't require vigorous activity, and also games where the children can stay socially distant. Some of the games are: Night at the Museum, Four Corners, Simon Says, and Freeze Dance.
