Our theme for the month is "Happy Halloween." We'll be doing a lot of fall and Halloween inspired crafts! An activities sheet will be handed out with all the different things we have planned for this month, so watch for that.

As you may have noticed, programs are operating a little differently this year. No parents are allowed to enter the school building. As you arrive, please call or text us so we can meet you at the door to sign in/out your child. If there is another family already at the door, please either stay 3 feet behind them or stay in your car until they are done to maintain social distancing.

Children and staff are required to be always masked inside during program. Masks are optional for children and staff outside.

CYC does not provide snack, so if your child(ren) needs a snack for the after-school program, please make sure you pack one for them.

We ask that children wash their hands immediately upon entry into the building. They will then be socially distanced within their groups. We will be focusing more on socially-distanced group activities this year and ask that children refrain from bringing any toys from home to program. Outdoor play will happen frequently, so as the weather gets colder please make sure your children have the appropriate clothing.

If your application is missing information, please remember you can update it at any time in the parent portal. Per OCFS regulations, each application must include two emergency contacts and a mailing address and phone number for every person listed on the application.
