CYC School-Age Childcare programs are licensed by the New York State Office of Children and Family Services.

And just like that October flew by! The month of October went by in a flash and we couldn't have had a smoother month without your help! The staff and I appreciate your patience as we continue to welcome new counselors to Sand Creek.

As the weather starts to transition into the colder months, we strongly encourage every child to have a coat or a sweatshirt for outdoor play. If they don't have one, we won't allow them to go outside because we don't want any of the kids to catch a cold or get sick. Masks are still required to be worn inside, with the option of wearing them outside, along with 3 feet social distance still being required.

During pickup those who are wearing a mask will be allowed in the vestibule to sign out and pick up their child(ren). With the cold weather approaching we don't want to keep anyone waiting outside for too long, but we do ask for your patience as we welcome new staff and attempt to get your kids signed out as quickly and timely as possible.

Please remember that Chromebooks can only be used for homework, or if it is in your child(rens) health care plan. We try to keep them away from electronics as much as possible and engage them in activities and games.
