IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Please remember that snack is no longer provided by CYC. Your child will need to come to the after-school program prepared with a snack and a water bottle is helpful as well.
- Extra masks and a change of clothes should be sent each day with your child. As the weather improves, we'll be outdoors a majority of the time and with spring comes mud and puddles.
- Chromebooks are for homework use only; no other electronics or toys from home are allowed.
- Masks are required and must be worn over the mouth and nose for the entire duration of program. Please encourage your child to speak with a staff person if they need a mask break!
- The same rules apply in CYC as in the classroom. Children should remain at their desks and if they need something, they simply should raise their hand and a staff person will be happy to help.
