Please make sure that your child(ren) is wearing appropriate footwear, either when they come to the program or a pair to change into before going to the gymnasium.

A sign will be posted on the door on the days the kids are in the gym so you can meet us on the other side of the school to pick up your child. This will alleviate a long wait at the usual door since the gymnasium is on the other side of the school.

New staff are still coming to Sand Creek, so we ask that parents or anyone on the registered pick-up form to have their IDs with them to ensure that your child(ren) is being released to the right people. The safety of the children is our top priority and we appreciate all of the patience and cooperation everyone has given us throughout the first month.
