Please be aware of our new pick-up procedure when the children are outside. Please call the site phone and come to the playground to get your child and sign them out. All of their belongings will be with them. We appreciate your cooperation with this new procedure!

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Snack is no longer being provided. If your child needs a snack during the after-school program, please provide them with one.
- As the weather gets warmer, we'll start to go outside more and more. Please make sure your children are prepared with weather-appropriate clothing. A change of clothing is probably a good idea as well.
- Children are expected to wear their masks correctly and remain socially distant during program hours. Often times the masks become unusable by the end of the school day so having an extra one in their backpack would be very helpful!
- Chromebooks are to be used at the designated times for HOMEWORK ONLY. If children are using their Chromebooks for purposes other than homework, we will be taking them and giving them back to you at parent pick up.
