Happy April Forts Ferry families!

My name is Noah and I'm the supervisor of the Forts Ferry Before and After-School Programs. Some families may recognize me from prior school years at Forts Ferry, Vacation Camps, or Summer Camp. I've been the Head Counselor at the Avis Drive After-School Program for the past two years and am looking forward to continuing my time with CYC at Forts Ferry.

Please make sure your child has additional masks with them in the event their mask becomes dirty or unusable. We also ask that you provide your child with a water bottle since they can't drink directly from the water fountain and we are no longer providing disposable cups. Also, if your child would like a snack at snack time please remember that CYC is no longer offering snack so your child will need to bring one to program.

In order for your children to go outside they need weather-appropriate clothing. The weather is finally getting warmer so please check the weather conditions each day and send the items your child will need to play outside

Many children bring their Chromebooks with them to program. Please note that Chromebooks are to be used for homework only.

Please remember that parents, grandparents, etc., are NOT allowed into the school to sign children in or out of program. We ask that you give our site phone a call to tell us you are here if one of us is not at the door already.

If your child(ren) bring any issues to your attention about grouping, please let Noah know ASAP so we can work on changes! We're all trying our best to accommodate your children's needs while maintaining safety protocols. Children are asked to wear their masks during the entire program, however they are more than welcome to ask a counselor for a mask break when needed.

Additionally, we cannot allow toys from home at this time as we can't sanitize their toys and prevent sharing like we wish we could. As intense as many of the new rules seem, we're simply trying to keep program as safe as possible!
