Toys and games will be sanitized at the end of each day. Parent drop-off will be at the childcare entrance which is straight ahead as you enter the parking lot. **Breakfast and lunch will be provided by the school district throughout the summer; menus are linked below and printed copies will be available at program..** A form is e-mailed to families in advance so we can provide the information to the district on Fridays for the upcoming week. **Everything your child needs each day is listed below in the "Important Information" section.** Toys from home are not allowed at this time. Electronics will be allowed this summer, but only during certain times of the day which will be clearly marked on the schedule.
