Camp hours are 7:30am – 5:30pm. Drop-off and pick-up will be inside the childcare entrance vestibule and a PIN will be required; if you haven't done so already please [create a PIN](#) for electronic attendance. At drop-off, you'll be greeted by myself or a staff member to sign your children into camp every day. Please be prepared with a photo ID until we become familiar with everyone.

This week's theme is **Fairytale and Fiction!** On Monday we'll have various activities planned for a day at camp. On Tuesday MISci will be visiting us for some science and technology fun! On Wednesday the children will need to bring their swim gear for our trip to the Colonie Town Pool; Thursday we'll remain at camp and will end the week at All for Fun Golf on Friday afternoon for a round of miniature golf and ice cream; no spending \$\$ is necessary but please prepare your child that we won't be using the go karts.

When we're not on field trips we'll be outside as much as possible as well as having free play options and designated *optional* electronic times. Designated electronic times will be during morning drop-off hours until 9:00 a.m., during lunch, as well as during the end of the day when the children start to leave.

Please send a towel with your child each day so we can enjoy a picnic lunch outside! Also if you wish to send sunscreen and/or bug repellent for your child, please be sure to sign a permission slip at drop-off. Children are not allowed to share sunscreen or bug repellent. **Refer to the "Important Information" section below for a list of items needed each day.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Sunscreen/Bug Repellent: Campers are not permitted to share sunscreen or bug repellent. Please send your child with his/her own bottle of sunscreen/bug repellent labeled with their name. Permission slip required.

Items from home: Unless otherwise noted on the parent table, toys from home are not permitted.
