# BASIC LIFE SUPPORT: \$95 - (\$90 cash payment)

### (formerly called BLS for Health Care Providers)

BLS is the foundation for saving lives after cardiac arrest. The AHA's BLS Course has been updated to reflect new science in the 2015 American Heart Association Guidelines Update for CPR and Emergency Cardiovascular Care (2015 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC). This Instructor-led course teaches both single-rescuer and team basic life support skills for application in both infacility and pre-hospital settings.

This course is designed for healthcare professionals and other personnel who need to know how to perform CPR and other basic cardiovascular life support skills in a wide variety of in-facility and pre-hospital settings.

### Who should take this class?

Emergency Medical Training Center provides CPR certification to healthcare providers like physicians, nurses, paramedics, EMTs, pharmacists, respiratory therapists, physical therapists, occupational therapists, physician assistants, medical residents or fellows, medical students, nursing students, nurses aides, medical or nursing assistants and other allied health personnel.

# HeartSaver CPR/AED with First Aid Course - \$110 (\$100 cash payment)

Emergency Medical Training Center provides CPR classes in Pennsylvania/New Jersey and surrounding areas to anyone with limited or no medical training who needs CPR/AED and First Aid certification to meet job or OSHA regulatory requirements. The AHA Heartsaver CPR/AED with First Aid class will teach you how to perform CPR on an adult, child or infant, teach you how to use a defibrillator or AED and will give you the skills to help in cases of choking. In addition, students will also learn various First Aid techniques.

In addition to the basic techniques of CPR and AED, the First Aid class teaches the lay person how to recognize and react to situations such as choking, low blood sugar, bleeding, broken bones and sprains, seizures, strokes, insect bites and stings, and temperature related injuries.
