

COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement for Patrons

In order to maintain the highest level of health and safety in the EDGE facilities, the EDGE will require that all members, guests, patients and program participants who are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine provide proof of vaccination or provide proof of exemption status, no later than Monday, October 18th, 2021. Those who have received the first dose of the two-dose vaccine and have the second dose scheduled will be allowed to enter, after providing proof of first dose and final dose cannot be later than October 31st, 2021.

FAQs

Why is The EDGE requiring COVID-19 vaccination for eligible members, guests and patients?

The EDGE has always been focused on public health and wellness. Vaccines have proven to be an essential tool to help keep the community safe and end the COVID-19 pandemic.

How will The EDGE collect this information?

Beginning Tuesday, September 28th, 2021, patrons will fill out a short and simple Vaccination Status Card at any one of the Front Desks that includes your name, phone number, email address, date of final vaccination shot and signature. An EDGE team member will then visually verify the date of final vaccination by looking at your vaccination card (the physical vaccination card or clear photos of the vaccination card are acceptable). This one-time process should be quick and easy. The EDGE team will then input a note on your account that will appear when you check in regarding your status.

What about those who are not currently eligible (ex. children under the age of 12)?

Those who are not eligible to receive the vaccine at this time due to age must wear a properly fitting face mask at all times and practice physical distancing (excluding children under the age of two). The EDGE will follow up with anyone submitting this exemption form with next steps.

Can I email The EDGE a copy of my vaccination card?

No, at this time, we will need to collect this information at the Front Desk with an EDGE employee visually verifying the person's name and date of vaccination on your COVID-19 vaccination card.

Are all people entering the building required to be vaccinated?

All eligible EDGE employees, members, guests and patients are required to be vaccinated or to provide verified exemption status. Vendors and other service providers are required to wear a properly fitting face mask and remain physically distanced while inside the facilities unless they provide proof of vaccination.
