Certified Rural Health Clinic Professional (CRHCP) – Fall 2020

Registration Opens **August 1st, 2020**

This extensive **ONLINE TRAINING** will prepare the learner to successfully run a Rural Health Clinic. The learner will gain full spectrum, in-depth knowledge of basic rules, regulations, and laws regarding RHCs from this course. The roughly 10-15 study hours may be done nights, weekends, or whenever as long as it's completed before Oct. 26. Those who complete the coursework & pass the final exam will be awarded the prestigious CRHCP credential.

COURSE FORMAT: ON-LINE including a final exam held on October 28th, 2020 which can also be taken on-line or in person at the conclusion of the 2020 NARHC Fall Institute in Phoenix. Attendance at the conference is a separate registration fee but is **HIGHLY** recommended to augment and reinforce the learning.
