

## Provider Relief Fund Reporting Portal Now Open

### Funds Received Before June 30, 2020 Must Be Reported By September 30, 2021

On June 21, NARHC published an [article](#) explaining the June 11 guidance regarding Provider Relief Fund use and reporting. The official HHS [reporting portal](#) opened on July 1.

RHCs who received aggregate funding of \$10,000 or more between April 10 and June 30, 2020 (which includes Phase 1 and 2 General Distributions and the Targeted Rural Distribution) were required to use this funding by June 30, 2021 and must report within the portal by September 30, 2021.

#### Key Reminders

- Providers are required to report in each reporting period that corresponds to the payment received period during which they received funding.
- You cannot report for multiple periods at once and you cannot report in advance of your corresponding reporting window opening.
- This is separate reporting than that which is required for RHC COVID-19 Testing and Testing and Mitigation Funding on [rhccovidreporting.com](#).
