Rural Health Clinic Experiences from the COVID-19 Testing Program

In April 2020, the Paycheck Protection Program and Health Care Enhancement Act was signed into law, awarding [\\$225 million](#) to the Rural Health Clinic COVID-19 Testing (RHCCT) Program. Throughout the last sixteen months, RHCs have utilized this funding to expand their COVID-19 testing capabilities, further their collaboration with other entities, retrofit their facilities, purchase needed supplies and equipment, and much more.
