This course will review the published evidence, indications and technique for placing a stainless steel crown on a primary molar without local anesthesia or tooth preparation; known as the Hall Crown Technique. This course will also explain the rationale and procedure for using resin modified glass ionomer to place esthetic crowns on primary anterior teeth without local anesthesia or preparation; a modified minimally invasive hall crown technique. Case examples of both restorations will be reviewed.

Participants will learn to:

- Understand the evidence and indications for use of the hall crown technique on posterior and anterior carious primary teeth
- Become familiar with the steps and procedure for placing a stainless steel crown on primary posterior teeth using the hall crown technique
- Become familiar with the steps and procedures for placing a resin modified glass ionomer crown on primary anterior teeth using a modified hall technique.
