RE: CRIMSI full year pilot 2022-2023



During the 2022-2023 school year, Garland ISD will participate in the full year COVID Recovery Instructional Materials Support Initiative (CRIMSI) pilot utilizing high quality instructional materials: Amplify K-5, Eureka Math K-5, Amplify 6-8, and Carnegie Math 6-8. While using the curriculum resources is non-negotiable, teachers will have the opportunity to earn a \$1500 stipend if

they choose to participate in the CRIMSI pilot and complete all requirements, per TEA. To ensure that all eligible teachers can participate in CRIMSI if they choose to, the district will register any teacher that is hired by August 5, 2022 that will be teaching with the above instructional resources.

Teachers can register for up to two products. For example, a self- contained teacher could complete the CRIMSI requirements for both Eureka math k-2 & Amplify k-2 and receive two \$1500 stipends, totaling \$3000. Teachers will only be registered for products they use for instruction.

Campus administrators and support teachers (ELST/CST/IST) will also have the opportunity to participate in the pilot as a coach. CRIMSI coaches can register for up to two products. For example, a principal could choose to be a coach for Eureka K-5 and Amplify K-2 with the potential to earn \$1500 for each product, totaling \$3000. At least one campus administrator from each campus is required to participate in the CRIMSI

pilot and serve as a coach. However, both the principal and assistant principal can be coaches.

Similar to the spring pilot, teachers and coaches will have CRIMSI requirements. Please check the links below for an overview of teacher requirements & coach requirements.
