

Old Town Project Celebration This Thursday, December 1 at the Goleta Valley Community Center

Please join the City of Goleta to celebrate the completion of the Goleta Valley Community Center Path Lighting Project, the HAWK signal, the signal improvements at Orange Avenue and the launch of the public parking program launched at Community West Bank. On Thursday, December 1 at 3 p.m., we will gather in the western parking lot in front of the Goleta Valley Community Center, 5679 Hollister Avenue.

Project descriptions:

Goleta Valley Community Center Path Lighting Project: Installation of path lighting from Hollister Avenue to the back of the property where the Boys & Girls Club is located. This project also included a new concrete sidewalk, removal of the old fencing and installation of a drainage swale between the path and parking areas.

Contractor: JG Contracting

Cost: \$125,401

HAWK Signal at the Goleta Valley Community Center: Installation of a High Intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) system. This is a pedestrian activated lighted crosswalk which replaced the flashing beacons. Additional enhancements include new striping and signage, additional lighting and relocation of the crosswalk approximately 100 feet to the east.

Contractor: Lee Wilson

Cost: \$133,434

Signal Improvements at Orange Avenue: Installation of a new pedestrian activated Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) over travel lanes on Hollister Avenue at Orange Avenue. The beacons will provide an additional visual cue to alert motorists when a pedestrian is crossing the street. The project also includes new striping and signage, as well as sidewalk improvements.

Contractor: Lee Wilson

Cost: \$97,665

Public Parking Program at Community West Bank

In an effort to make it easier for people to park in Old Town, the City has made an agreement with Community West Bank to make their lot on Hollister available for public parking. There are now 18 parking spaces available for use by patrons of Old Town businesses. The available spaces will be labeled for public use to differentiate from those reserved for Community West Bank customers. The spaces can only be used during daylight hours and vehicles must not exceed the length of the parking spaces.
