

**Peter Dion Receives the Chapman Award  
National Conference in Orlando Florida

The Charles F. Chapman Award for Excellence in Teaching is an annual award program that provides Squadron, District, and National recognition to outstanding individual instructors. At the National level, the Chapman Award is the highest recognition and honor that USPS can give to individual instructors who are selected as the “best of our best” each year.

National honorees will receive a recognition plaque, a gold Chapman Award lapel pin, and a four-year certified instructor wallet card; and their names will be inscribed in a permanent Log Book kept in the Chapman Memorial Library at USPS headquarters in Raleigh. Each honoree’s Squadron will be recognized and receive a commemorative gift (\$500), underwritten by the USPS Educational Fund and given in the honoree’s name. The \$500 gift was used by ABCHH toward the purchase of a new laptop computer used for our education classes.
