Mission Statement



- 3.To uphold our commitment to have a diverse student community while offering policities that hold students accountable to the school's high standards of learning.




Nationality Mix

Students at the A1 Level can use very frequently-used daily expressions as well as simple phrases to meet immediate needs. You can ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, things he/she has and people he/she knows. You can also interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to cooperate.

Students at the A2 Level can repeat sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g., very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment). You can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters. You can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.

<u>Students at the B1 level</u> can interpret the main points of clear, familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc. You can apply English to most situations likely to arise while travelling in an area where the language is spoken. You can produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest.

Students at the B2 Level can respond to the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in your field of specialization. You can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party.

Students at the C1 Level can analyze a wide range of demanding, longer texts, and recognize implicit meaning. You can express yourself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions. You can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes.

Students at the C2 Level can interpret with ease virtually everything heard or read. You can summarize information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation. You can express yourself spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in more complex situations.


