### Free Tutoring: The After-school Newcomb Tutoring (ANT) program

ANT pairs Tulane undergraduates with local elementary and middle school students in order to provide homework help and reinforce understanding of fundamentals like basic arithmetic and reading comprehension.

Tutors are paired with the same children each week, so over the course of the academic year they are able to build close bonds with their tutees and act as their mentors, while at the same time helping their students improve their grades and performance in school.

**ANT takes place on Tulane's campus in the classrooms of Newcomb Hall on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 6:00-7:00 pm.** With our program, your students will get the chance to develop a constructive mentor-mentee relationship with someone who is further along in his or her academic career.
