
Linda Retchin & Jeff Solomon interviewed by Jan Zatzman Orlansky

Jeff Solomon and Linda Retchin are a powerful duo, each with their own style and independent careers. If harnessed, their energy combined could power a small country! They have run over one hundred 5Ks and now they are very active with the local Dragonheart Vermont Dragon Boating team, which requires year-round training and commitment. Linda paddled with Team USA in 2015 at the World Championships in Welland, Ontario. She served ten years on the Vermont Board of Dental Examiners after being appointed by Governor Howard Dean. She now sits on the Vermont Board of Radiologic Technologists as a Public Member and was recently reappointed to this position by Governor Phil Scott. In addition she is a national Dental Hygiene Examiner for CDCA, a national credentialing agency.



For Temple Sinai, Linda has been a Trustee and also has been

President and Treasurer of the Sisterhood. She served for four years as the Oneg Coordinator. She often remarks that she cast the deciding vote to install air conditioning in the synagogue years ago. Linda and Jeff have been members of Temple Sinai for 30 years.

Jeff graduated from Bowdoin College in Maine (he was Phi Beta Kappa) and then went to Cornell University for graduate school in Mathematics and Statistics. He quipped and quoted that "If I had only one day left to live, I would live it in my statistics class... It would seem so much longer!"
