



Sanskrit Weekend at Waterperry House 25th – 27th November 2022

This weekend is offered as an introduction to Sanskrit with study centred on ‘Search for Reality’, a new translation of a Sanskrit text teaching the philosophy of non-duality. The weekend will be led by the translators, Warwick and Elena Jessup. There will be recitation and more detailed study of one verse with particular reference to key Sanskrit words. Those having prior experience with Sanskrit are also very welcome. The weekend will take place at Waterperry House near Wheatley in Oxfordshire.

The weekend is open to all. Students will be asked to help with the catering and cleaning needed in the house, which will be minimal.
