

# Greetings, Lake Deaton Friends and Family!

As we come to the close of this extraordinary year, your LDUMC Leadership Team felt it would be appropriate to give you an update on the State of Lake Deaton UMC. Your Lake Deaton Leadership and Staff have worked hard to continue a wide variety of ministries and activities all designed to support our mission: *To make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the World.* 

In May of 2020 members of NCUMC voted to launch Lake Deaton UMC as an independent UMC. We began that process officially on June 1<sup>st</sup> immediately following the congregational vote and Charge Conference approving to move forward with the launch of LDUMC. Over the next 6 months leadership and staff worked to complete the transition from being a campus of NCUMC to being an independent United Methodist Church, Lake Deaton UMC. As of this date, the transition is complete. Lake Deaton United Methodist Church is an independent UMC.

The launch gave us the opportunity to create many of our own operational processes.

First, we launched the Lake Deaton UMC website. You can access this site at <a href="www.lakedeatonumc.com">www.lakedeatonumc.com</a>. Just about anything and everything you ever wanted to know about LDUMC is there. If you haven't already, please check it out. While there, we would encourage you to click on Resources, then the Ministry One App link. This will take you to a page where you can access either the App store or Goggle play, search for and install Ministry One. This is a directory of our church. We would also encourage you to check your information in the Profile section to ensure it is accurate.

Also, we have implemented new ways to communicate. Every Thursday, LDUMC sends out an electronic Newsletter entitled Lake Deaton Happenings! Included in this communication is a 5 to 10-minute video "Couch Talk". This video will give you a quick update of current activities. The Newsletter also features short articles on activities that may interest you and/or you may wish to connect with. This newsletter is being sent to approximately 980 individuals. What a year we have had so far in 2020. Certainly, the challenges presented to us personally and as a church are challenges unlike any that most of us have experienced in our lifetime. Despite the challenges, one of those being our launch from the New Covenant umbrella, we have thrived as a church thanks to our generous congregation, our staff, and our pastors. Specifically, as to our finances, we project that we will have received by year-end around \$1,300,000 versus expenses totaling \$1,260,000. Accordingly, that should leave us around \$40,000 that will be added to our reserves. These numbers are amazing given the challenges presented by the pandemic, challenges that we look to continue to have through the first six months of 2021. Our budget for 2021 has been approved and projects \$1,350,000 in contributions and expenses. We will closely monitor our results as we work into 2021 and adjust the budget as necessary. We, as a financial committee, pledge to the congregation that we will make sure we make any decisions, regardless of how hard they might be to ensure the financial viability of Lake Deaton United Methodist Church.
