OLIN BROWNE: Yup. I made a mistake, I made a bad mistake on 10. We just misjudged the wind. I thought the wind wasn't there and it was and I just flew the green. You know, in retrospect, when we got up to the green, we could feel it. You know, that was my only real mistake of the day. Actually, my only real bad mistake of the week. Then on 15 I just hit a very poor tee shot. The rest of the time I hit really good shots. I hit a beautiful iron shot on 17, caught a line that was really a big breaker and just missed it on the low side. And then here on 18, I don't know where my ball landed.

Q. It landed just over the bunker in the fringe.

OLIN BROWNE: Yeah. So it bounced hard?

Q. Yeah. That was unfortunate.

OLIN BROWNE: And I had kind of a difficult lie and I made what I thought was a pretty good play. It ran out a little bit more than it did. I read it straight, played it straight and it broke left. Then Tom Pernice on the same line -- hey, you know what, I love what I did this week. I had so much fun. It was fun being in the mix. You know, you're playing with guys like Freddie Couples and Tom Pernice, who have been playing so great for so long. I'm very pleased. I would take two shots over again and take whatever happens after that.

Q. Perry had the same putt to win.

OLIN BROWNE: As I had?

Q. For eagle to win.

OLIN BROWNE: Yeah, so if he reads it right, he's going to make it. But I'll tell you what, it's a dead straight putt and you just can't miss it one way or the other. If you do, it's going to go that way. It's straight into the grain.

Q. So you've got to hit it hard?

OLIN BROWNE: Yeah. Well, not just hard. It's got to be a pure roll. Whatever happened on my putt, my ball broke this far out of the middle of the hole and Tom's ball actually went right. So difficult putt. You know, some days those things happen.
