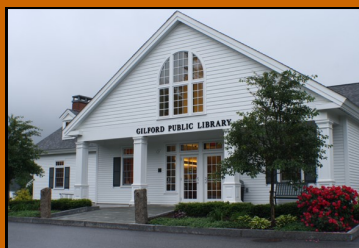


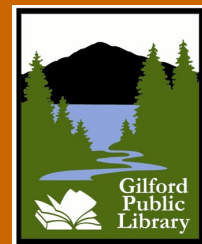

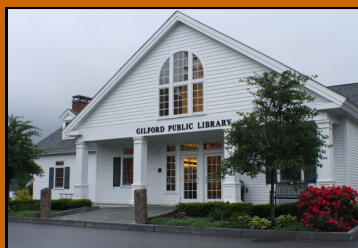
This is a joint program with Thompson-Ames Historical Society. This program will have a limited in-person attendance of 11 people. Call the library to sign up for in-person or Zoom.

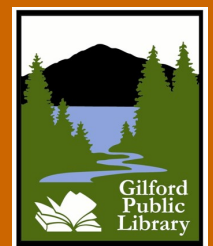

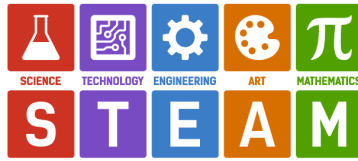
WHAT'S POPPIN'?

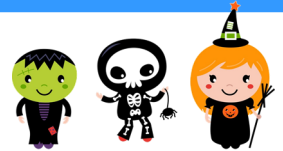
MOTHER GOOSE ON THE LOOSE
