

## The Lipsky/Whittaker Scholarship Information Sheet and Application 2022

“Young Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Questioning (LGBTQ) men and women will grow up without the fear of rejection, violence, discrimination or exposure to HIV/AIDS.” –John Lipsky & George Whittaker

The mission of the Lipsky/Whittaker Scholarship is to support youth activism in support of LGBTQQ rights. The Lipsky/ Whittaker Scholarship supports Rhode Island residents who are pursuing an educational program beyond high school graduation. Students enrolled full-time in a post-secondary program resulting in either a certificate of completion or an Associate or Bachelor degree are eligible to apply for the scholarship.

The Scholarship gives out \$10,000 per year; amounts per student may vary. Renewal scholarships will be considered for students in good standing in their chosen educational program.

Applicants must be:

- A Rhode Island high school graduate (or a high school student graduating in the spring/summer of 2023), under the age of twenty-four, and
- Enrolled (or planning to enroll) full-time in a post-secondary technical training program, two or four year college; and either
  - o Identify as LGBTQQ, or
  - o Be raised in an LGBTQQ household, and
  - o Have a substantial history of activism in support of the rights of LGBTQQ individuals and families.

The Lipsky/Whittaker Scholarship is focused on supporting and growing youth activists who are dedicated to the rights of LGBTQQ people and families to be “free from the fear of rejection, violence, discrimination or exposure to HIV/AIDS.”
