The Highlander Institute, an educational non-profit located in Providence, RI, aims to cultivate and disseminate innovative education solutions that improve educator and system capacity to provide personalized experiences for every learner. At this year's annual Personalization 2020 Conference, we plan on bringing to light the urgency around building a positive school climate and culture for LGBTQ+ youth and their allies.

Through participating in this survey about your school experiences, it will provide data to share with teachers and school leaders to cultivate a more affirming and welcoming space for LGBTQ+ youth in our local schools. We are conducting the survey so that we can assess the school climate and culture - how comfortable students of different backgrounds are in school, how common offensive language is in the hallways, and how common other types of harassment are. The survey contains questions about you, your school and your experiences in school, including your experiences with harassment and assault at school.

You do not have to identify as LGBTQ to take part in this survey.

We ask that you please complete the survey in one sitting. We ask that you complete every section and all questions so that our data can be as accurate as possible.

You can choose to stop taking the survey at any time.

Because the survey is anonymous, we hope that you will be comfortable being completely honest when answering these questions. You can also skip a question at any time.
