2015 La Rioja Alta 'Vina Alberdi' Reserva (Rioja, Spain)

This has been one of my favorite red wines for years and years. As a token piece of evidence to that point I will share that I have a vintage LRA advertising poster framed in my dining room. It has rarely (if ever) appeared as a staff selection here because it seemed that there was always something going on with the supply chain that made it difficult or impossible to really promote this to a wide audience. Thankfully we seem to have much of that sorted out, AND we are on the leading edge of a great vintage release in the 2015 bottling. La Rioja Alta is well-known as one of the Rioja houses that stands for traditional winemaking techniques and styles for its wines. What this really boils down to is that they avoid deep extraction techniques that often make wines heavy and tannic, and they use a judicious amount of new oak in their barrel-aging regime. The wines are often mid-weight, with some obvious (but delicious) oak presence that I find hard to resist. This bottling is the product of the magnificent 2015 vintage that blessed vineyards across Europe with bountiful crops of well-balanced, ripe, and expressive fruit. Put through the LRA wine-making system, and you get a modern classic. This shows bright red-fruit flavors up front with some high cherry notes followed by some darker notes of plum and blackberry as the wine lingers on your palate. The fresh oak lends aromas and flavor notes of brown spices perfect for fall cuisines. This wine is drinking well now for sure, but will also reward a few more years of cellaring if you can keep your hands off them! (13961)

2018 Ch. Bellegrave Pauillac (Bordeaux, France)

Pauillac is a small town on the Left Bank of the Gironde Estuary as you drive north out of Bordeaux along the D2, Bordeaux's famous 'wine route.' It is an unassuming town, with little about it that would make you think much about wine. And yet, Pauillac sits at the historic epicenter of all that is Bordeaux. The vineyards that surround the town are arguably some of the finest on the planet for Cabernet Sauvignon. It is the clear leader of the entire region in terms of quality. Of the top five properties on the Left Bank, three of them (Latour, Lafite Rothschild, and Mouton Rothschild) are located here. There simply isn't very much vineyard land that doesn't belong to or feed into the 18 "classified growth" properties. This is why Bellegrave is important. This property is one of perhaps a half-dozen to exist here outside of the official classification system. Primarily Cabernet Sauvignon, boasting the traditional blackcurrant, cigar-box, and lead-pencil shaving flavors, this bottling is unmistakably from Pauillac, and yet it costs a fraction of what most of this town's wines sell for. Whether you are new to the wines or Bordeaux or have been drinking them for years, I'm confident that you will be impressed. (114894)

2018 Hexamer 'Quarzit' Riesling (Nahe, Germany)

If I have something to thank 2020 for, it's rediscovering Riesling's affinity for food. Cooking has always been a therapeutic act for me, and during these past few months, making meals for my family and neighbors has proven that immensely. It also made me consciously aware that very few other grapes offer the flexibility Riesling has with an array of dishes, and the ability to make the combination of bite and sip seem like a mini fireworks display. Through the course of cooking (& ordering out), Riesling proved it could make cheese taste like the best version of itself, balance the richness of grilled sausages and succulent pork shoulder, and tame the fiery heat of the spiciest of cuisines. I know some of you are already checked out because of the mindset that Riesling = Sweet, end of story. But, please, read on. With the ABV sitting at 11% - (11%!) the Hexamer Quarzit is barely off-dry (dry table wines like Sauvignon Blanc start at 12%). It is the wine's inherent fruitiness (apricot, lychee, lemon mousse), showcased by that hint of sweetness, which makes this such a versatile food partner. The grapes come from vineyards owned by Petra and Harald Hexamer in the storybook town of Meddersheim in Germany's Nahe region. The wine is named for the quartzite and red slate filled soil which supplies both verve and minerality to this Riesling's fruit notes. Once on the palate, an incredible mouth-filling zesty-ness brings about an almost savory finish. It is certainly fun to sip by itself, but trust me when I say - the real magic here happens when you start cooking. (10346)

2018 La Cabriole Cabernet Franc (Saumur, Loire Valley, France)

Cabernet Franc, one of the five principal grapes of Bordeaux, seems to have found an ideal home about 4 hours north in the Loire Valley. The varietal is known for being beautifully aromatic, with flavors that can include dark fruit, cocoa, pencil lead, and occasionally green notes that can range from pepper to dried herbs. In their youth, these wines have a spicy acidity, making them a perfect partner for tomato-based dishes. With age, Cab Franc can develop a huskier presence and complexity. I find both completely enjoyable. The 2018 La Cabriole, while young, has qualities of both styles, which means you should feel free to open some now and stash some away for later! This wine is so pretty. I love everything from the aromas to the enveloping flavors of blackberry, raspberry, and plum fruit to the herbaceous spice notes that offer depth to the wine without adding heaviness. La Cabriole is precisely the type of wine I picture served at quaint Bistros and dinner tables throughout France. It should be at your house, too. (113640)



2018 Cave de Saumur 'Les Epinats' Blanc (Loire Valley, France)

Saumur is an area along the Loire River in France. Here the chalky soils are planted with the Chenin Blanc grape and can come in a wide range of sweetness levels. This lovely dry version comes from a single vineyard within this multi-family wine cooperative. The wine shows pear and nectarine aromas and flavors, excellent mouthfeel and texture, and a crisp finish. I find it a fitting wine for this time of year when temperatures fluctuate between the last blast of summer heat to the first chill of fall, and likely the food on your table might be experiencing that same flux. A glass of "Les Epinats" will find fit right in with an array of shellfish, grilled chicken, even a savory, seasoned pork chop. (21592)

2019 Pullus "Halozan" White Blend (Liter) (Slovenia)

Halozan is a dry white wine from Slovenia. It comes in a liter size, which I feel is necessary since it is so incredibly easy to drink. The technical data would point out that it is a blend of eight different grapes that are fermented separately before blending and then given a short aging period in steel tanks before bottling. The result is loads of fun. Peach and pear fruit, citrus tang, and a flavorful, refreshing finish all come together to create this delightful wine that works so well with a wide variety of smoky, salty, and savory dishes. 2018 La Posta Tinto (Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina)

Argentina and Malbec go together as well as any wine varietal and world-class wine country could. This La Posta red blend is very popular at Surdyk's, with great taste and value. Made mostly of Malbec (60%), with Bonarda added for richness, and Syrah for spiciness. La Posta is known for sourcing fruit from small-family growers, and this comes from the Uco Valley in the famed Mendoza wine region. I like this red blend a lot. I find aromas of red and black berries and plenty of soft spice on the finish. Flavors are lush, and 9 months of oak barrel aging make this a well-balanced wine full of fresh fruit, soft tannin, and lively acidity. Pair this red blend with smoky grilled meats and roasted vegetables. Our sale price is right on and you get a lot of wine for your money. Argentine red wine is perfect for fall fare and this is a Surdyk's must-buy! (24668)

2018 Hahn GSM Red Blend (Central Coast, California)

Five years ago, I visited the Central Coast of California, where I discovered what a scenic and festive place it is with a wonderful wine-growing region loaded with great vineyards making delicious

French Rhone-style wines. The Hahn family arrived from Switzerland in the late 1970s and decided to start their winery in this special place. One of my favorite wines from Hahn is the GSM red blend, made from Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvedre, a combination made famous in the Rhone Valley. This is a wonderful food wine that provides flavor and substance to a good meal of roasted meat and vegetables. It will be a hit at any gathering. The Grenache grapes come from Arroyo Seco vineyards and provide fruity flavors of raspberry, strawberry, and red cherry. The Syrah from the Santa Lucia Highlands adds vivid color and black pepper spice notes. Dark Mourvedre fills in richness and tannic structure. The result is a perfect red wine taste that is a solid favorite on my table. During our sale, you can buy this at a great discount, making it the best time to stock up for the coming holiday season. 2017 Vinum Cellars 'PETS' Petite Sirah (Clarksburg, California)

Vinum Cellars is a winery that I enjoyed representing in my past role as a Distributor Sales Rep. They have playful labels (this one has a picture of the original vineyard dog named Tanker), offer an extremely good price to value, and yet they take their wines very seriously. The winery, which is located in Oakville, works closely with well-respected growers throughout California. This wine is called PETS, which is a slang term that growers use to refer to Petite Sirah. Vinum Cellars' PETS has been sourced from Wilson Farms in Clarksburg for the past 20 years. This wine is impressively dark in color, almost inky black. It shows intense aromas of blackberry, cassis and vanilla from aging in French oak barrels. The palate shows tons of lush ripe fruit and silky-smooth tannins which, fortunately, are perfectly balanced by vibrant acidity that leads to an endless finish. That acidity comes from the daily mid-afternoon cooling winds coming from the San Francisco Bay. This wine will complement all grilled meats, smoky carnisas tacos, and grilled portobello mushrooms. Cheers to this great wine and to Tanker the original vineyard dog pictured on the label! (110892)

2019 Saladini Pilastrini Rosso Piceno (Marche, Italy)

Surdyk's customers often ask me to recommend an affordable wine to go with a simple weeknight meal like pizza, pasta, or hamburgers. The trick is avoiding the myriad of red wines close to \$10 that at best taste jammy and flat, and offer very

little varietal accuracy. We have an Italian wine at Surdyk's that is perfect for your go-to affordable red wine, Saladini Pilastrini Rosso Piceno DOC. This winery is located in the Marche region on the east coast of Italy, which is heavily influenced by its proximity to the Adriatic ocean. The wine is certified organic and is made up of 80% Sangiovese and 20% Montepulciano. It sees approximately 4 months in French oak barrels. The nose has some drier herbs, red fruits, and subtle hints of earthiness and vanilla. The palate is medium bodied, with the spicy herbs and red fruits showing up in the mid palate, while the acidity and subtle vanilla help to sharpen and focus the finish. This is a great bargain for such quality in the glass, so I can assure you that you can't go wrong if you always have an extra case on hand! Salute! (16842)

Black Tot Rum is a tribute to July 31st, 1970, known as "Black Tot Day," when the British Navy ceased the centuries-old tradition of giving a daily "tot" (2.4 oz) of rum to sailors. This day from now on is known as Black Tot Day. Elixer Distillers researched and recreated a rum typical of that classic daily tot. The new Black Tot has the same core of 3 Caribbean rums most typical of historic tots. It is a rich, golden marriage of fruity Barbadian, full-bodied Guyanese, and vibrant Jamaican Rums. Unsweetened, non-chill filtered, and bottled at a higher proof (46.2%) traditional of a sailor's daily ration. Aged in ex-bourbon barrels, and matured 100% in the Caribbean. Pick this rum up and put away your mixers. This one's a seductive and rich sipper. (114939) (6/case)

Extra Dry (115089)

This classic vermouth uses Piedmontese Moscato and Erbaluce grapes infused with botanicals grown on the nearby Occitan Alps. Perfect on the rocks, delicious with some tonic water, and able to elevate a gin or vodka martini to new heights.

Bianco (115091)


