Across France, the 2018 vintage began with a spring that was long, cool, and dramatically wet. This gave way in early summer to seemingly endless weeks of sunshine, heat, and dry northerly breezes. All the water at the beginning, then all the sunshine at the end. In between, many vineyards struggled with mildew and canopy management issues, but the end of the growing season allowed vineyard managers to harvest at will, and they delivered to their winemakers an ample crop of beautiful fruit. 2020 Nortico Alvarinho (Vinho Regional Minho, Portugal)

In recent years, the most popular white grape to emerge from the Iberian Peninsula is known as Alvarinho in Portugal and Albarino in Spain. Most of the offerings at Surdyk's are Albarinos from Spain, so I wanted to revisit one of my favorite grapes when it is grown in Portugal. The 2020 Nortico Alvarinho is from the best, sustainably farmed vineyards in northern Portugal, on the border with Spain. These vineyards were planted in granite soil over the course of almost 100 years (from 1910 to 2005) and near the ocean, which provides a subtle taste of salinity on the finish. The wine shows stunning aromas of lush, tropical fruits that evolve and gain complexity. On the palate, the wine is lively and full-bodied at the same time, with peach and citrus fruit balanced by vibrant acidity and minerality. This wine is lip-smacking good and incredibly versatile. Enjoy on its own, or pair with salty dishes like charcuterie, or fish tacos, or the way my oldest daughter prefers, with grilled smoked oysters. 2018 Sattler St. Laurent (Burgenland, Austria)

Over the last few years, I have recommended to our customers that they give this Austrian red grape called St. Laurent a try. I have continued to enjoy every one of the recent vintages (with the possible exception of 2017) of the various producers and bottlings that we carry. This particular wine by Sattler stands out to me for its unabashed effort to push the envelope of what St. Laurent is capable of. Traditionally we think of this grape as a sort of cross between the silky softness of Pinot Noir and the dark plunging depth of Mourvedre. The resulting wine is soft, easy to drink, and yet dark and brooding, with something of a signature note of smoke (not from charred barrels or nearby fires mind you, but from the grapes themselves). I like to recommend this wine to folks who are tired of Pinot Noir but still want something new and interesting. This particular bottling is remarkably rich and supple given the types of wines produced heretofore, which tend, like Pinot Noir, to be made in a lighter style. Flavor points for this wine are decidedly on the dark side, black cherry and plum primarily, but then that smokiness and the seemingly absent tannins make this wine both captivating and an easy drink. Highly recommended with anything off the grill or with a little char, or try in place of that Rioja with a classic paella. (24384) Reg. \$16.99

2018 Sella & Mosca Cannonau di Sardegna Riserva (Sardinia)

The French say Grenache, the Spanish say Garnacha. But Sardinians say Cannonau, and their island's lesser-known version of this deservedly popular wine grape variety may be the wellspring from which it spread through the Mediterranean region and beyond. Regardless, though, of whether the grape originated on the island or on the Spanish mainland—researchers are still debating the question—it's indisputable that Sardinians have been enjoying the soul-satisfying red wine they make from Cannonau for many centuries. And they may live longer as a result: Minneapolis's own Dan Buettner, of Blue Zones fame, has identified Sardinians' moderate but steady consumption of Cannonau wine (which is unusually high in antioxidants) as one of the secrets to their remarkable longevity. The excellent bottle from Sella & Mosca is made from grapes grown on their vast Piani estate in the northwest corner of the island. Give it a minute or two to allow the still-bright acidity to mellow a bit, and then savor the delicious dark fruit flavors of blueberries and plums topped off with a hint of spice. 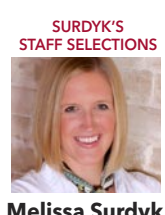

Tozai "Snow Maiden" Junmai Nigori (720ml) (Kyoto, Japan)

In this time of challenge and unpredictability, when uniformity and the recognizable would presumably bring comfort, we continue to see a draw into the sake cooler, many looking to try something new. With the popularity, great price point, and value of the Tozai line at Surdyk's, I did not hesitate to look closer at Tozai Snow Maiden Nigori when it made its way across my desk. New to Surdyk's, Snow Maiden is named after Hanako, or "Flower Maiden," the most famous Japanese koi fish that lived for 226 years in the snowy, icy waters at the foot of Japan's Mt. Ontake. From Kyoto, known as one of the best places for brewing sake due to pure soft water that runs from the surrounding "purple" mountains. This loosely filtered nigori style sake is luscious and creamy, with crisp notes of honeydew and savory buttery pumpkin - a sake sure to bring welcomed comfort this fall. 2019 Dry Creek Vineyards "Heritage Vines" Zinfandel (Dry Creek Valley, California)

California Zinfandel is very popular at Surdyk's for a reason. Always well priced and a dynamite pairing for the barbecue. When I drink Zinfandel, Dry Creek Vineyards "Heritage Vines" is always my first choice. For 47 years, they have grafted century-old vines to new rootstock, presenting the "heritage" of older, more flavor-matured wines and their grapes. It all works to produce a really good Zin. Grapes are harvested from Sonoma County hillsides from ideal clay loam soil. Dry Creek adds a small amount of Petite Sirah to the mix for color and structure and darker, drier fruit vitality. The Zin spends two full years in oak barrels aging. The finished wine has a fabulous taste - blueberry and raspberry fruit flavors on top of smooth tannins, with a signature spice of white pepper, dark chocolate, and light vanilla from the oak barrels. The Dry Creek Zinfandel shows fresh, full flavors without being "jammy." Considered one of the best wines produced in Sonoma. Delightful! Stock up while it is on sale. (7088)

Piattelli Vineyards Brut Natural Sparkling (Argentina)

Here's a new wine from a familiar brand here at Surdyk's, Piattelli. Don't let the Italian name fool you; this is an Argentinian sparkling beauty that has quality and taste all over it! Made with traditional French varieties of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir in the Champagne style of Methode Champenoise, this sparkler is refreshingly good. The foremost tasting impression I had with my first sip was... full, rich, and fun bubbles in a dry, crisp texture that was brisk and cheering to drink. You'll find a fine yeasty brioche flavor with apple, pear, and citrus notes that last well into the finish. Champagne from France sells from the \$30s on up. This Piattelli is well under \$20 on sale, and a real bargain. No need to wait for a celebration to pop this cork. Enjoy often with everyday food! 2017 Villion Syrah (6/case) (South Africa)

The Villion family of S. Africa have been grape farmers in the Cape of Good Hope ever since the first French Huguenot, Francois Villion, arrived in 1671. Their goal is to produce world class wines using careful selection criteria that include vineyard

age/location; sustainable farming and natural production methods like spontaneous fermentation; different vine clones; and proximity to the ocean. When I first tasted this Syrah several years ago, the wine jumped out to me as beautifully complex and absolutely delicious! I have since enjoyed several vintages which show the subtle variations provided by Mother Nature each growing season. The core style remains the same, with a complex nose of ripe black cherry and red berry fruit, floral notes, and cigar box/tobacco spice. The palate shows intensity and depth of fruit flavors, balanced by dried herbs and spice, framed by fine grained, polished tannins that lead to a focused and LONG finish. We will certainly see the vintage move from 2017 to 2018 during this sale period, which offers a great opportunity to see and taste those subtle differences for yourself. Cheers! 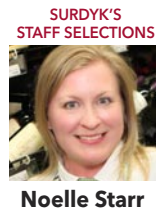

2019 Domaine de la Madone "Le Perreon" Beaujolais-Villages (Beaujolais, France)

I own an enormous collection of cookbooks. While I would like you to believe that I cook elaborate meals regularly, most nights, dinner is something simple. My trick to making even the most boring weeknight meal exciting is the wine. Gamay, the grape of Beaujolais, has become what I frequently turn to, thanks to its food friendliness. Domaine de la Madone's "Le Perreon" bottling is one of the best we carry. This is not Beaujolais-Nouveau, the fruity, light wine that is released in November of each year. In fact, its Beaujolais-Villages classification seems inadequate for this cru-level quality wine. Madone's vineyards are on average over 50 years old. Farming is practicing organic with such steep hillsides that manual harvest is the only safe option. This wine has tons of character; gorgeous aromatics (berries, earth, and violet) and so much flavor that isn't ever heavy or thick. Best of all, it makes just about any meal feel special. It elevates a humble roast chicken, has enough acidity to stand up to tomatoes in any form, and is mind-blowing with salmon. Even if all you have in the house is some cheese and crackers - this wine will make you feel like you are in a quaint bistro in France. (15875) Reg. \$15.49

2019 Domaine de la Bressande Mercurey Blanc (Burgundy, France)

Burgundy, home to some of the world's most breathtaking Pinot Noirs and Chardonnays, is a daunting region for most wine drinkers. Some of you have spent both time and money exploring this section of our store, but most people I help have an understandable amount of confusion when it comes to this region. Burgundy's location (just northeast of the center of the country) means blessings of warm summers and extremely mineral-rich soil. But it also includes threats of severe weather which can interrupt the grapes' ripening. Fortunately, Chardonnay thrives here. So much so that we have certainly seen a shift in how domestic Chardonnay is made to emulate the Burgundian style - clear fruit with the subtle enhancement of neutral French oak, allowing for a more elegant expression of the grape. Domaine de la Bressande is a small commune located in Mercurey, one of the southern districts of Burgundy, that delivers something not often found in this region: value. I love the scents of baked apple, marzipan, and a hint of salinity that comes before the flavors of spiced pear, apple, and honeycomb. I have been fortunate to taste some lovely (read: expensive) white Burgundy and to me, this feels equally special. Not to mention, it is a perfect match for the fall season. (111668) Reg. \$27.99

Maker's Mark Cask Strength Bourbon (Kentucky)

Before the decades-long bourbon boom that still shows no sign of waning, Maker's Mark was the very definition of a premium bourbon. But as the frenzy over high-quality American whiskeys intensified, Maker's seemed at times to get lost in the shuffle, even though it boasts a wheat-accented mash bill like some of the most sought-after trophy bourbons (namely, Pappy and Weller). Then, with the introduction seven years ago of their cask-strength bottling, Maker's proudly proclaimed: Game on! As robust as regular Maker's is mild-mannered, this is a fabulously full-flavored bourbon that can stand up to a little water or ice without backing down. If it's been a while since you've tried Maker's Mark, now is the perfect time to get reacquainted. (108628)
