Accepted artwork will be displayed at the Gaylord Rockies Resort Convention Center for our conference participants to view and vote on their favorites.

ATTENTION: Due to limited space at the Gaylord Convention Center allocated for the Art Contest this year we are requiring students to submit a photograph of their art piece to CAGT with the required paperwork (see below) no later than noon on Monday, October 25. The Conference Committee will review all complete submissions and select outstanding work that will be displayed at the NAGC Convention. All artists will be notified by November 4th if their piece has been chosen.

* In the event NAGC's Convention needs to cancel the in-person event due to COVID, CAGT will do the Art Contest virtually. If this happens, we will notify everyone as soon as we know.

CAGT Student Art Contest: Application and Guidelines

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR ARTWORK

Eligibility:

Any student enrolled in a K-12 Colorado school or homeschooled is eligible to participate.

Student Level: Select your level based on the 2021-2022 school year. Select **only** one:

____ Elementary (K-5) ____ Middle School (6-8) ____ High School (9-12)

Guidelines:

- Art should be an original, creative interpretation of the theme: *The Beauty of Colorado Inside and Out*.
*Note: We want **your vision** of the theme, NOT a depiction of the convention's logo.
- Each student can submit *only one* piece of art. **One picture per piece needs to be sent as a jpeg or png.**
- Artwork must be the student's original concept, not a copy of anyone else's copyrighted material, and the student must be the creator of the art. The student is solely responsible for any infringement on copyrighted materials.
- If the project is done in class, the project must be an original, creative interpretation of the theme. This should *not* be done for a different project and made to try to fit the theme. Additionally, if this is a class project, only 1 or 2 of the best depictions of the theme should be submitted to the CAGT Art Contest.
- Art can be 2D or 3D. 2D pieces must have dimensions no larger than 24 inches x 36 inches and must be matted (See example at the bottom of document). Framing is allowed, but not necessary. 3D pieces must have dimensions no larger than 24 inches x 24 inches x 24 inches.
- A copy of the student information (the blank form is above) must be filled out and sent in along with the picture of the artwork.
- Art will be displayed on the Student Art Contest page on the online and mobile app where attendees will be able to vote on their favorites.
- One winner from each group (elementary, middle school, high school) will be determined by conference attendees. All winners will be awarded a \$50 gift card.
