Dear CECFC Families,

I want to thank you all for your support and understanding as we navigate educating our students during this difficult year. We want to provide you with an update today on how we plan to return to school after our Spring Break. Beginning Monday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>, CECFC Middle and High School students will return to in-person learning four days a week, Monday-Thursday. Fridays will remain an asynchronous remote day for all our students to allow our teachers to better serve remote-only students.

Bringing all our students back to school four days a week does mean the exposure our students have in classes and hallways will increase. We will maximize social distancing and continue to follow our safety protocols, but we want our families to know that maintaining six feet of distancing will not always be possible, especially in classrooms. Students and staff will still be required to wear masks and the enhanced cleaning and disinfection of our schools and workplaces will continue. Ventilation will remain a focus and as the weather improves this semester, we will use outdoor spaces more frequently. Our team will continue following protocols based on medical best practices and public health guidance to promptly respond to cases. The number of cases in our school will continue to be provided in our weekly announcement to ensure our families are aware of what is happening in our buildings.

Even with these precautions in place we know some families may not feel comfortable sending their student to school with the increase in exposure. We also know we have families that have elected to be remote because the changes between in-person and at-home learning each week was difficult for their student, but they would like to be in-person if that can be consistent. With that in mind, all of our families have the option to elect to switch to fully remote or in-person learning if they would like to at this time. We are asking that any family that would like to switch learning modality for their student fill out this form by **end of day Tuesday, March 9<sup>th</sup>**.

Remember, all our families have a part in keeping our school open and allowing us to return to in person learning. We need you to continue to reinforce the importance of wearing a mask, watching/being conscious of social distancing, and washing hands to your students. If you are traveling or have an increased amount of exposure over spring break, we encourage you to keep your student home and get tested before returning to school. Our ability to keep our doors open depends on students following these safety measures. If we all do our part to follow the protocols put in place by the school and health officials, we will be able to continue in person learning for the remainder of the year.
