## About The Program

The BA/BS-MD degree program at the University of Colorado Denver (CU Denver) | Anschutz Medical Campus aims to promote diversity and to better serve the health care needs of the state of Colorado by assembling up to 10 outstanding students per year from broadly diverse backgrounds who are committed to serving the health care needs of Colorado. The program is a partnership between the University of Colorado Denver College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and the University of Colorado School of Medicine.

Admission of students will be conducted through a holistic review to select academically qualified individuals from a broad range of backgrounds who show a strong commitment to a career in medicine and to serving the people of Colorado.

## Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to apply for the Combined BA/BS-MD Program at CU Denver | Anschutz Medical Campus a student must:

- Apply to and be accepted for admission as a degree seeking student at the University of Colorado Denver Downtown campus.
- **Be current residents of the State of Colorado** and a citizen of the United States, a DACA recipient, or a U.S. permanent resident with a Form I-551, I-151, or I-551C.
- Be a current senior **in a Colorado** high school planning to begin college the fall semester after graduation.
- Possess a personal commitment to a career in medicine.
- Colorado public colleges and universities consider the following in making admissions decisions:
  - High School GPA
  - Test Scores
  - Academic course mix and rigor
  - Extracurricular activities and other considerations



### \*\*\*A successful BA/BS-MD applicant should have:

- A minimum high school grade point average of 3.5 (weighted or unweighted; whichever is higher).
- A composite ACT Score of 27 or higher or an Evidenced Based Reading & Writing +Math SAT Score of 1185 or higher.  
\*\*\*\*\*Note that ACT or SAT scores are not required for the 2023 application cycle. If an applicant has scores and would like to submit them, they can choose to do so as supplementary material (scores reported on high school transcripts are acceptable).

## Why Apply to CU Denver | Anschutz Medical Campus BA/BS-MD Program?

Connecting the BA/BS-MD students to the University of Colorado Denver and Colorado communities alike is a primary goal of the BA/BS-MD Program. Students in the program benefit from the following:
