## *The Disruptors: A Positive Light on ADHD*

Join us for a screening of “The Disruptors,” an award-winning documentary on ADHD. “The Disruptors” explores realities of parenting neurodivergent children and the learning curve of turning ADHD struggles into strengths. The documentary dispels misconceptions around ADHD and explains the brain chemistry of ADHD through comprehensive research and interviews with a range of experts. “The Disruptors” also attempts to reframe society’s understanding of ADHD from a deficit/disorder model to one that is much more dimensional, and demonstrates that, managed properly, ADHD can be an asset and not a liability.

The screening will be followed by a Q&A session with the film’s Emmy-nominated executive producer Nancy Armstrong P’22,’24 and Dr. Ned Hallowell (via Zoom), a board-certified child and adult psychiatrist, one of America’s foremost experts on ADHD, and the founder of The Hallowell ADHD Centers.
